# Ports of Call

## **KUSADASI, TURKEY**

Explore the ruins of ancient Ephesus: the famed Library of Celsus, the amphitheater, chariot marked marble roads, mosaic sidewalks and the superb, rarely opened Terrace Houses. Or, journey to three monumental cities of antiquity – Priene, Miletus and Didyma, renowned for their majestic temples and stadiums.

## **DELOS, GREECE**

Stroll through the remains of ancient temples on this uninhabited island, a much revered sanctuary of antiquity. Silent marble lions still stand guard at the legendary birthplace of Apollo, where the temples' splendid mosaic floors are a sight to behold.

## **MYKONOS, GREECE**

Wander through the winding streets of this lovely seaside village. Discover a kaleidoscope of whitewashed houses, flowers, brightly painted shutters and doors. Stand beneath the windmills on the hill and visit the fascinating Archeological Museum.

## **SANTORINI, GREECE**

Visit the beautiful whitewashed hilltop towns of Oia and Fira with their fantastic views. See the stunning artifacts in Fira's museum, including recent finds from the excavation of Akrotiri. Visit a winery and take in the local color.

## **RHODES, GREECE**

Enjoy a walking tour of the old fortified city and stand in awe of the impressive Grand Master's Palace. See where the Colossus of Rhodes once stood and savor the history of this remarkable walled town. Or drive along the scenic coast to whitewashed Lindos, climb to the ancient Acropolis, explore its temples, revel in its wonderful views.

## **CRETE (AGHIOS NIKOLAOS), GREECE**

Discover fascinating ancient Minoan and Byzantine villages, see the panorama of lovely windmills, visit a monastery, or head across the island to see the reconstructed Palace of Knossos.

## **MONEMVASIA, GREECE**

Once declared the "Gibraltar of Greece" due to its location upon main sea routes of the Mediterranean, the island of Monemvasia is a charming mix of winding cobblestone alleyways, handsome red-tiled rooftop homes, stunning views, and a medieval fortress. Dramatically perched upon a cliff overlooking the sea is the 13th-century citadel, the Church of Ayia Sophia.

## **KATAKOLON, GREECE**

Visit ancient Olympia where the Olympic Games began in 776 B.C. and stroll around this deserted Sanctuary, admiring the temples, altars and treasuries, and stand on the ground where ancient athletes practiced before competing. Or enjoy a pleasant drive through the countryside past quaint villages to a local vineyard and sample the wines, local cheeses and other foods.

## **CORFU, GREECE**

Immerse yourself in this beautiful island of glorious scenery and beaches, serene monasteries, beautiful palaces, traditional mountain towns and Corfu's lovely old Venetian quarter. Or learn to prepare traditional Greek dishes at a local restaurant and feast on the results.

## **ZAKYNTHOS, GREECE**

Indulge in the magnificent scenery of Zakynthos, where pine-covered mountains meet golden beaches, where traditional villages thrive alongside new developments, and where fertile plains produce rolling vineyards and olive groves. Zakynthos is home to ancient churches, archaeological sites, famous sea caves, and the endangered sea turtle, Caretta-Caretta.

## **NAUPLION, GREECE**

Residing on the eastern coast of the Peloponnese peninsula, Nauplion is characterized by the Palamidi Fortress – a shining example of the city's Venetian occupation in the 15th century. The picturesque vista showcasing the Greek Islands is certainly worth the 999-step climb.
