Donna J. Perry, PhD, RN, is a nurse scientist and humanitarian. She is associate director of the Thomas S. Durant Fellowship for Refugee Medicine at Massachusetts General Hospital. She also manages global nursing education in the Institute for Patient Care at MGH. Her program of research focuses on decision-making concerning contemporary issues of social transformation related to peace, justice and human rights. Perry is active in community service and serves as volunteer vice president of ACCESO, an NGO that sponsors humanitarian delegations to Cuba to deliver books and disability equipment and to promote Cuban-American relations. Perry has published a number of peer-reviewed journal articles, book chapters and a book.
