Bob’s Boston Liturgical Dance ensemble will lead us in following the journey of Jesus to Calvary. Easter Egg Hunt – Palm Sunday, March 20th, following the 10:00 am Combined Liturgy - Once again, our Grade 7th and 8th grade students will organize and host our Easter Egg Hunt for children in pre-school through Grade 5. Lower Church: (September – June) 10:00 AM, Family Liturgy

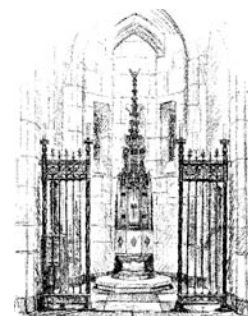
