Dear Parishioners,

This past weekend I had the pleasure of visiting another Jesuit parish in Cincinnati. The pastor of St. Francis Xavier is Fr. Eric Knapp S.J. You may remember Eric from when he was a deacon here at the Parish or from his running the Boston Marathon in remarkable time. It was such a grace-filled experience seeing the faith-filled community that Eric has animated in his parish. Like St. Ignatius, St X's draws people from all over Cincinnati and northern Kentucky. It was so clear to me that the Spirit is very much alive in Cincinnati and not just because of the "REDS" (that's an allusion to Pentecost!).

One of the highlights of my visit was Eric's taking me to a MegaChurch service, a non-denominational Christian service that gathered at least 2000 people on a Saturday evening. Although the service was too "theatrical" for me (can you imagine!!!), I was, nevertheless, moved by the power of the Spirit to animate people's minds and hearts with a love for Jesus Christ and a desire to live the Gospel as authentically as possible. As a Catholic, what I found lacking was the intimacy with Christ and the community that comes through the Eucharist. It reminded me of the rich tradition we share as we gather weekly to "eat and drink" in memory of Jesus.

I share my weekend journey with you to point out that the Spirit of God is always moving, creating new experiences of God's love and mercy. Like those first disciples who gathered in the Upper Room at Pentecost, we too can be moved by the Spirit to do wonderful things for God and for our world in the name of Jesus Christ. At the end of this Easter Season, let me sing an Alleluia of gratitude for your life in the Spirit and for the love that shows itself so powerfully in your generosity and commitment to the Good News!

Happy Easter! Happy Pentecost! Alleluia!

## THE SACRAMENTS

### BAPTISM

Adults are baptized at the Easter Vigil as part of the Rites of Christian Initiation for Adults. Infant and child baptisms are by arrangement.

### FIRST EUCHARIST

Preparation occurs in Grade 2 and includes classes, retreat and home instruction.

### CONFIRMATION

Our Confirmation program begins in the 9th grade. Students are confirmed in the Spring of the 10th grade. Young adults who have been catechized but are not yet confirmed should contact the rectory for an alternative program.

### MATRIMONY

Must be registered as a parishioner six months prior to beginning Marriage arrangements.

### RECONCILIATION

Saturdays 3:15 - 3:45 PM Upper Church or by arrangement
