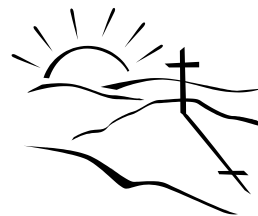

STRENGTH IN WHAT REMAINS: A PRESENTATION AND DISCUSSION

Deo Niyizonkiza, who founded a small non-profit called Village Health Works, which does work in Burundi, will be giving a talk at St. Ignatius about his work and experiences. Village Health Works is working with community members in the rural village of Kigutu (located approximately 70 miles south of the capital city of Bujumbura) to develop a model community health center. This health center provides critically needed primary care to the 40,000 people of Kigutu and the surrounding area. 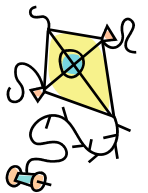

THE SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM

Adults are baptized at the Easter Vigil as part of the Rites of Christian Initiation for Adults. Infant and child baptisms are by arrangement.

FIRST EUCHARIST

Preparation occurs in Grade 1 and includes classes, retreats and home instruction.

CONFIRMATION

Our Confirmation program begins in the 9th grade. Students are confirmed in the Spring of the 10th grade. Young adults who have been catechized but are not yet confirmed should contact the rectory for an alternative program.

MATRIMONY

Must be registered as a parishioner six months prior to beginning Marriage arrangements.

Saturdays 3:15 - 3:45 PM Upper Church or by arrangement
