INFORMATION ABOUT THE PETITION DRIVE FOR ASSISTED SUICIDE

Between now and December 7th supporters of a bill to legalize physician-assisted suicide will be working to gather 68,911 signatures from Massachusetts voters. This is the first step in putting this measure on the ballot in November, 2012. The position of the Church is that all suicide is a tragedy. In a recent homily, Cardinal Seán said, “A vote for assisted suicide is a vote for suicide”. Please consider Church teaching if asked to sign the petition for this suicide initiative.

THE SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM

Adults are baptized at the Easter Vigil as part of the Rites of Christian Initiation for Adults. Infant and child baptisms are by arrangement.

FIRST EUCHARIST

Preparation begins in Grade 1 and includes classes, retreats and home instruction.

CONFIRMATION

Our Confirmation program begins in the 9th grade. Students are confirmed in the Spring of the 10th grade. Young adults who have been catechized but are not yet confirmed should contact the rectory for an alternative program.

MATRIMONY

Must be registered as a parishioner six months prior to beginning Marriage arrangements.
