On Wednesday, November 28th at 7:30 p.m. Bishop John Dooher will celebrate a Mass of Remembrance for survivors of clergy abuse who have died. This Mass will be held at Our Lady Help of Christians Church, 573 Washington Street in Newton. Together, let us remember these beloved children of God. Let us pray for an outpouring of God's mercy, love and peace for all who grieve. And, as we remember, let us pray as one for the continued healing of all survivors, their families, and for our Church. All are welcome to attend.

## THE SACRAMENTS

### BAPTISM

Adults are baptized at the Easter Vigil as part of the Rites of Christian Initiation for Adults. Infant and child baptisms are by arrangement.

### FIRST EUCHARIST

Preparation occurs in Grade 2 and includes classes, retreat and home instruction.

### CONFIRMATION

Our Confirmation program begins in the 9th grade. Students are confirmed in the Spring of the 10th grade. Young adults who have been catechized but are not yet confirmed should contact the rectory for an alternative program.

### MATRIMONY

Must be registered as a parishioner six months prior to beginning Marriage arrangements.

### RECONCILIATION

Saturdays 3:15 - 3:45 PM Upper Church or by arrangement
