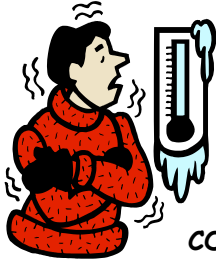

THE ENNEAGRAM - Have you ever wondered why you do the things you do? And why other people do the things they do? The *Enneagram* is an ancient method of personality typing which has been used for centuries to increase self-knowledge. Because the *Enneagram* is basically an oral tradition, it is best learned in workshops. Gail O'Donnell, RSCJ has been giving *Enneagram* workshops since 1980 and will be the presenter of a workshop to be held on Saturday November 14, 2009 from 9:30-4:30 in the Friary Room. THE SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM

Adults are baptized at the Easter Vigil as part of the Rites of Christian Initiation for Adults. Infant and child baptisms are by arrangement.

FIRST EUCHARIST

Preparation occurs in Grade 1 and includes classes, retreats and home instruction.

CONFIRMATION

Our Confirmation program begins in the 9th grade. Students are confirmed in the Spring of the 10th grade. Young adults who have been catechized but are not yet confirmed should contact the rectory for an alternative program.

MATRIMONY

Must be registered as a parishioner six months prior to beginning Marriage arrangements.

RECONCILIATION

Saturdays 3:15 - 3:45 PM Upper Church or by arrangement

ANOINTING OF THE SICK by arrangement
