REGISTRATION FOR 2009 – 2010

St. Ignatius Faith Formation has begun the registration process for the 2009 – 2010 academic year and will continue throughout the summer. As usual, the earlier you register, the easier it is for our office. Because we are grateful when you register early, we will ask for a “pre-registration” donation of \$200 per family. After **September 20**, our registration fee will be **\$250** per family.

How to register:

Via Email

An electronic copy of our registration form will be sent out starting June 4. You can return it via email – please be sure to sign the bottom in acknowledgement of the policies listed on the reverse side of the form. If you choose this method, please submit a check to the rectory at your earliest convenience.

Via the web

Our registration form will be posted online beginning June 4. You can download the form there and return it via email or via traditional post. Again, please do sign the form to acknowledge that you are aware of the policies on the reverse side.

THE SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM

Adults are baptized at the Easter Vigil as part of the Rites of Christian Initiation for Adults. Infant and child baptisms are by arrangement.

FIRST EUCHARIST

Preparation occurs in Grade 1 and includes classes, retreats and home instruction.

CONFIRMATION

Our Confirmation program begins in the 9th grade. Students are confirmed in the Spring of the 10th grade. Young adults who have been catechized but are not yet confirmed should contact the rectory for an alternative program.

MATRIMONY

Must be registered as a parishioner six months prior to beginning Marriage arrangements.

Saturdays 3:15 - 3:45 PM Upper Church or by arrangement
