In the year 2010, the Community of Oberammergau will perform for the 41st time the Passion Play they have preserved throughout the centuries with singular continuity. Corpus Christi-St. Bernard Parish of Newton will sponsor a trip to the Passion Play – including visits to sites in Germany and Austria – from August 24-September 1, 2010. THE SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM

Adults are baptized at the Easter Vigil as part of the Rites of Christian Initiation for Adults. Infant and child baptisms are by arrangement.

FIRST EUCHARIST

Preparation occurs in Grade 1 and includes classes, retreats and home instruction.

CONFIRMATION

Our Confirmation program begins in the 9th grade. Students are confirmed in the Spring of the 10th grade. Young adults who have been catechized but are not yet confirmed should contact the rectory for an alternative program.

MATRIMONY

Must be registered as a parishioner six months prior to beginning Marriage arrangements.
