For the spring semester the **Jackson Mann Elementary School** became a participating school in our **Read Boston Program**. Currently, **five Boston College students** are working with children two mornings a week in the classroom. We are thrilled to be partnering with the Jackson Mann Elementary School and look forward to growing the program in the fall. We are in our **tenth year of a Read Boston partnership** with our other participating schools, the **Hamilton Elementary** and the **Winship Elementary** and where **twenty five BC students** work with children during the school day and in the after-school program.

Tutoring Programs

The **One-on-One Tutoring Program** through the Neighborhood Center continues to be **record breaker!** The program has grown to over **125 tutoring matches!** Each week Boston College students tutor neighborhood children on the Boston College campus. And we have over **50 BC students volunteering at St. Columbkille's, the Garfield, the Winship and the Jackson Mann Schools** in their after-school programs.
