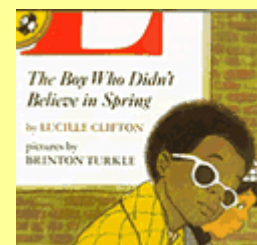
- There will be **NO SCHOOL** from **April 14th-21st** for Boston Public School's Spring Break.
