Hello and welcome back to Boston College!

As we begin the fall 2023, we at the Office of Global Education are excited to help students begin their study abroad journey.

For students approved for the spring 2024 semester, your Program Managers will be in touch throughout the semester regarding next steps. Should you have any questions, please contact your Program Manager for more information.

If you are hoping to study abroad during the 2024-2025 academic year, planning for next year begins now. All students wanting to study abroad next academic year, must apply by January 5, 2024. This is the deadline for all semester study abroad applications (fall 2023, full year 2024-25, and spring 2025). If you miss the deadline you will not be able to study abroad next academic year. Students also have the option to

apply for a Summer 2024 faculty-led program or internship abroad by February 5, 2024. Learn more about OGE Summer Programs on our website.

Students should carefully review our "Getting Started" page to learn how to begin. All students will need to complete an Initial Advising Questionnaire and attend a Study Abroad 101 session to be eligible to apply to any semester study abroad program. This includes all Boston College and all approved, non-BC external programs. Our office offers multiple Study Abroad 101s each week until the end of the fall semester. The 101s begin September 11 and will end in December; please plan accordingly.

Our website offers more details regarding programs abroad, requirements, academic considerations, financial matters, and additional resources. To complement our general advising and the website, OGE Program Managers (Study Abroad Advisors) can help answer your questions,


address any concerns, and offer advice to help you find a program abroad that best meets your interest and goals.

Benjamin Gilman Scholarship

To be eligible for the Gilman Program, applicants must be receiving a Federal Pell Grant during the time of application or provide proof that they will be receiving a Pell Grant during the term of their study abroad program or internship. The deadline to submit an application for Spring 2023 and early consideration for Summer 2023, Fall 2023, or Academic Year 2023-24 programs is October 5, 2023, at 11:59 pm Pacific Time. Fund for Education Abroad

The Fund for Education Abroad (FEA) provides scholarships and ongoing support to students who are underrepresented among the U.S. study abroad population. FEA makes life-changing, international experiences accessible to all by supporting students of color, community college, and first-generation college students before, during, and after they participate in education abroad programs. The deadline to apply to Spring 2023 programs is September 20, 2023, at 12 pm (noon) EST. McGILLYCUDDY-LOGUE FELLOWS PROGRAM




