Parking

All visitors to campus should park in the Commonwealth Avenue Garage. Weekend parking on campus is free.

Where to Go Upon Arrival

When you park in the Commonwealth Avenue Garage, you can take the elevators to the 7th floor of the garage, walk out the back of the garage, make a left, and walk up O'Neill Plaza toward the front of Devlin Hall (see website links for map). In the alternative, if you decide to walk out of the garage on the bottom floor, make a right out of the front of the garage and walk down the sidewalk, where you can take the set of stairs all the way up to Devlin Hall, which will be the first building in front of you when you reach the top of the stairs. All efforts will be made to have visible signage in the front of Devlin Hall and we will also have people available in front who will provide you with any additional directions and/or instructions that you may need.
