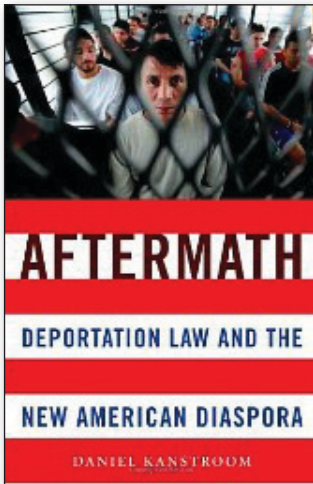

Detailing research both in the U.S. and abroad, Prof. Kanstroom examines the large and increasing number of deportees that have been expelled from the U.S. and the harsh realities they often face in their new communities. He closely examines the current deportation regime and whether it “works” in any meaningful sense, while offering his recommendations for reform to create a more human and just system.
