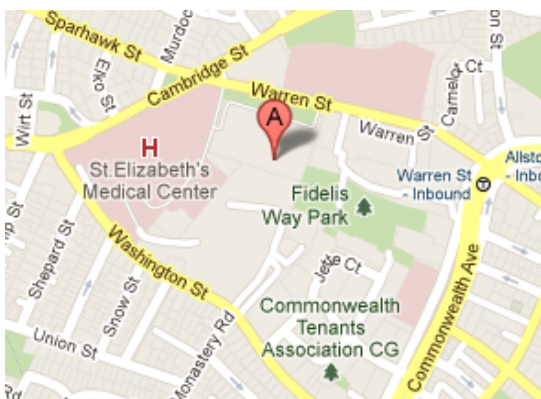

Step up to COLLEGE with LET'S GET READY!

*Let's Get Ready (LGR) prepares high school students to apply to college through our 9-week College Prep courses. The courses are offered **FREE** to participating students.*

What do you get by participating?

- ⇒ **Test-taking skills to prepare for the SAT**
- ⇒ **College admissions and financial aid guidance**
- ⇒ **Small-group instruction**
Coaches are trained college students with high SAT scores on the section of the SAT that they teach. They work with students in small groups, with no more than 5 students per coach.

To participate you must:

- * Want to go to college
- * Plan to take the official SAT exam
- * Be first-generation college bound or eligible for free or reduced lunch (exceptions made for special circumstances)
- * Complete an application and take a diagnostic exam
- * Pay a \$25 deposit, which will be refunded to you if you:
 - 1) Take 2 diagnostic exams
 - 2) Attend all program classes (with no more than 3 absences)



Registration Process

- * Fill out an **application** *on paper* or *online* at:

- * Pay the **\$25 deposit** at the Program Introductory Session.
- * Take a **diagnostic exam** to complete the application process.

When and where do classes meet?
