*****Hate Crimes:** For calendar year 2014, there was no reported hate crime. For calendar year 2015, there was one hate crime reported as having occurred On-Campus which was reported as racial bias (a clerical error in last year's printed version of these statistics incorrectly included this 2015 hate crime report in the On-Campus Student Housing Facility category). For calendar year 2016, there was one hate crime reported as having occurred On-Campus in an On-Campus Student Housing Facility which was reported as racial bias.

****Unfounded** counts are not included in other counts or total fields in this report, other than the total fields for the Unfounded column. Institutions are required to publish the number of "Unfounded Crimes" beginning with calendar year 2015 crime statistics. Boston College has elected to voluntarily report this information for 2014 crime statistics in advance of the requirement taking effect.

***On-Campus Student Housing Facilities** crime statistics are a subset of the On-Campus category, i.e. they are counted in both categories.

¹ For years 2014 and 2015, the number of persons referred for disciplinary action for On-Campus liquor law violations was changed from 889 to 1,113 in 2014 and from 908 to 1,506 in 2015, and the number of persons referred for disciplinary action for liquor law violations in On-Campus Student Housing Facilities was changed from 816 to 1,070 in 2014 and from 812 to 1,368 in 2015. ² For years 2014 and 2015, the number of persons referred for disciplinary action for On-Campus drug abuse violations was changed from 121 to 154 in 2014 and from 96 to 108 in 2015, and the number of persons referred for disciplinary action for drug abuse violations in On-Campus Student Housing Facilities was changed from 104 to 135 in 2014 and from 82 to 94 in 2015. The reason for these changes is that the disciplinary software system used in 2014 and 2015 did not properly categorize certain disciplinary referrals, most of which involved referrals in which the University determined the student referred for discipline had not violated any drug or alcohol laws. The University switched to a new disciplinary software system, and in September 2017 while using it to review the disciplinary referral statistics for this year's report, identified the disciplinary referral categorization issues with the prior software. Boston College does not tolerate the illegal possession, transportation or consumption of alcohol by its students on-campus, off-campus or in University residence halls, which house more than 7,600 undergraduates. All known alcohol-related incidents that appear to violate law are referred for disciplinary action for which a record is kept and which may result in the imposition of a sanction. All students subject to such referrals are included in the disciplinary referral statistics above even if the University subsequently determined that the student referred for discipline had not violated any alcohol laws.
