Dear Parents of Graduates:

Our planning for Commencement 2013 is already underway and we are anticipating a special celebration for Boston College's 137th Commencement. It will take place on Monday, May 20, 2013, in Alumni Stadium on campus. Commencement 2013 will be the Sesquicentennial Commencement, marking the 150th anniversary of our founding. The pages that follow include a schedule of Commencement and pre-Commencement events as well as other information that we hope will be helpful as you make your plans to celebrate the graduation of your son or daughter from Boston College.

While there are many events that take place in the days leading up to May 20, two are of special importance. On Sunday, May 19, at 12:00 noon, the Baccalaureate Mass will be celebrated in Conte Forum. Members of the BC Jesuit Community, Campus Ministers, members of the University Chorale, and many students participate in the Baccalaureate Mass. The University Commencement will be held on Monday, May 20. The main University Commencement Ceremony is held in Alumni Stadium; the academic procession begins at 9:15 a.m. At 12:00 noon each school and college holds its Diploma Ceremony at a campus location.

During the month of May more than 50 area colleges and universities hold their commencement ceremonies, so it is extremely important that hotel reservations be made as soon as possible. A link to a list of some of the area's hotels, guest houses, and reservation services is included in this newsletter.

We have also included the Boston College Commencement website address as well as other important contact information. We hope you will feel free to call or write with any questions that come up as you begin your planning. Additional information is available on the Commencement website and a brochure with all details will be mailed to you in March.

We look forward to welcoming you to campus in May for this very special Commencement and the graduation of your son or daughter.

During the month of March, each student will receive access to a specially designed electronic invitation. This invitation may be sent by the student to family and friends.

DECEMBER GRADUATES

All December graduates are invited to participate in the University Commencement in May 2013.

For undergraduates completing their degrees in December, there will be a Baccalaureate Mass on December 11, 2012, at 4:00 p.m. in Gasson Hall, followed by a reception for graduates and their families. No diplomas will be presented at this time. Diplomas will be mailed in early January to the graduate's home address as listed on Agora.

In November, additional information on the December Baccalaureate Mass will be sent to undergraduates graduating in December.

COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

The Commencement Speaker will be announced by the student newspaper *The Heights* and other University publications in mid April.

SPECIAL AWARDS AND CEREMONIES

Students will be notified in advance if they are receiving a special award from their school or college or if they have been nominated as a Phi Beta Kappa inductee. The presentation of these awards will take place either at a special Award Ceremony on Sunday, at the individual Diploma Ceremonies on Monday, or at the Phi Beta Kappa Initiation Ceremony on Sunday.

CAP AND GOWN RENTAL

Academic regalia may be rented or purchased from the University's vendor, who will be on campus to measure and take orders during the following days and times:

Wednesday, May 15, 12:00 noon to 7:00 p.m.

Thursday, May 16, 12:00 noon to 7:00 p.m.

Friday, May 17, 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Advance online ordering is encouraged; however, students must pick up their regalia in person at the dates and times listed above.

Those renting will be able to drop their regalia off at a variety of sites after the conclusion of the Commencement activities.

INDIVIDUAL PHOTOGRAPHS

Each school and college arranges to have a photographer take a photo of each graduate receiving his or her diploma. Information on placing an order will be sent in advance.

PARKING

For the Baccalaureate Mass on Sunday, families and guests of graduates may use the entire parking area on Lower Campus including the two garages.

Since close to 25,000 people attend Commencement on Monday, travel to the campus is extremely slow because of heavy traffic volume. Please allow ample time to reach campus. Lower campus parking, including one of the two garages, is available for graduates and their guests. However, given the significant number of attendees, there is not adequate campus parking. Two satellite sites, the Brighton Campus and the Newton Campus, are available for BC parking and shuttle bus service is provided to the Stadium.

Additional parking information will be included in the March mailing.

STUDENTS AND GUESTS WITH DISABILITIES

There are special arrangements for students and guests with disabilities.

Any student requiring special arrangements should contact his or her Dean as soon as possible.

Guests with handicapped license plates or placards will be provided with reserved parking in the Beacon Street garage on Commencement Day.

Special seating for those confined to wheelchairs will be provided both at the Baccalaureate Mass and on Commencement Day.
