To avoid repetition of course content taken elsewhere, students are given an opportunity to test out of certain foundation courses and substitute more advanced electives. Both Proficiency Exams will be offered on August 29, 2011.

- Students must earn a grade of 80 to get a passing grade. Students will be notified of the results.
- The exam will be taken anonymously and each student will be given a coded number to place on the exam does not know whose exam they are correcting.
- Each exam is 2 hours long.
- There is no charge for the exam.

If a student passes a proficiency exam, s/he is exempt from taking that required course, but must substitute a three-credit elective in its place.
