- ❖ An STM academic year student is defined as a student who takes more than two three-credit courses in the academic year to complete his/her program. STM academic year students need 44 credits total, which includes 37 credits in STM courses *and* to fulfill all requirements listed below in order to complete the program.
- ❖ STM requirements are requirement areas, not specific courses, unless a course number is given. Students with a limited background in theology should take introductory courses. Those without a previous degree in theology should take introductory courses. Those with a previous degree in theology can take more focused or advanced courses. Please consult the Degree Requirements sheets to determine which courses fulfill which requirements *and meet with your advisor at least once per semester to select your courses.*
- ❖ Please consult the Academic Policies section of the Student Guide or the STM website for information on transferring credits, three-credit summer courses, weekend and on-line courses, independent studies, etc., pertaining to your STM courses.
- ❖ TM 644 and TM 730 should be taken as soon as possible in the student's course of studies.
- ❖ The whole MA/MA program must be completed in six years.
