

# Parking

*There will be no overnight parking on campus from Thursday, Sept. 25, through Sunday, Sept. 28.*

**Please also note that towing will be enforced throughout the weekend.**

## FRIDAY PARKING

All parents attending Parents' Weekend activities during the day on Friday should park on Newton Campus. Please refer to the enclosed map for directions and parking information. Parking attendants will be on site for assistance.

If you are planning to arrive on campus before 8:30 a.m., you will still be directed to park on Newton Campus.

Minibuses will be available starting at 8 a.m. to take you to Lower Campus. These buses will run between Newton Campus and Lower Campus every 10 to 15 minutes throughout the day, stopping at Robsham Theater and Conte Forum bus stops, as marked on the accompanying campus map.

If you are staying for Pops on the Heights: the Barbara and Jim Cleary Scholarship Gala on Friday evening, we request that you keep your car parked on Newton Campus during the concert to avoid traffic congestion. Motor coaches will be available at both exits of Conte Forum immediately following the concert to

bring you back to Newton Campus.

## SATURDAY PARKING

Parents' Weekend guests attending the Pregame Barbecue and the Boston College football game must plan to park at one of the two satellite parking lots in Needham or Brighton.

Shuttle service will be available every 10 minutes, beginning three hours prior to kickoff and ending two hours after the conclusion of the game. Those with limited mobility should plan to park at the satellite lot in Needham.

## Needham Directions:

Take I-95/Route 128 to Exit 19A (Highland Avenue). At the first set of lights, take a right onto 2nd Avenue and follow the appropriate Boston College parking signs.

## Brighton Directions:

Travel to the lot at 1 Guest Street across from the Stockyard Restaurant in the New Balance parking garage.

*Please note that parking on the BC campus will reopen three hours after the game.*

Parking will be available on campus in both the Beacon Street and Commonwealth Avenue Garages.

## HANDICAPPED PARKING

**Friday:** Guests who require handicapped access will be able to park in the marked handicapped parking spaces in surface lots on Lower Campus. You will need to present a state-issued handicapped placard. Please enter through the St. Ignatius Gate, and do not park in either of the garages.

**Saturday:** Guests with state-issued handicapped placards may park at the satellite lot in Brighton or Needham. Those with the most limited mobility may park in Lot B of the Needham satellite lot for direct access to the stadium via shuttle. There are accommodations for persons with disabilities on shuttles at both satellite parking lots.

**Sunday:** Handicapped parking will be available throughout campus to those with a state-issued handicapped placard.

## PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Parents are also encouraged to take the MBTA Green Line to Boston College. BC can be reached by a variety of MBTA stations. The Green Line B, C, and D trains have stops within walking distance of Alumni Stadium. Please visit the MBTA website at [www.mbta.com](http://www.mbta.com).
