For Art History, English, Hispanic Studies, History, International Studies, Latin American Studies, Philosophy, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, and Teacher Education students:

- Click on "Artes liberales"
- Click on "Carreras"
- Click on a discipline to view course offerings

For Business and Economics students:

- Click on "Administración para el desarrollo"
- Click on one of the four disciplines: Marketing, Administración, Finanzas, or Economía
- When the new window opens, click on the name of the discipline again
- Click "Descripción de Cursos" to view course descriptions

For Biology and Environmental Studies students:

- Click on “Ciencias biológicas y ambientales”
- Click on “Carreras”
- Click on “Descripción Cursos 2007” to view course descriptions

For Communication students:

- Click on “Comunicación y artes contemporánea”
- Click on “Carreras”
- Under “Concentraciones en comunicación,” click on any of the three disciplines listed
- Scroll down to view courses offered during **Segundo semestre**
- Click on “Descripción de Cursos” to view course descriptions

For Pre-Med, Pre-Vet, Pre-Dental, and Nursing students:

- Click on “Ciencias de la salud”
- Click on “Carreras”
- Click on one of the four disciplines under “Pregrado”
- Scroll down to view course offerings

Please be aware that in order to receive approval for major, minor or University core credit, students may need to present course descriptions and/or syllabi to faculty responsible for course approvals. Please contact Dr. Amanda Grunauer for specific syllabi, if needed.
