

## **Dever Fellowship Application**

1. The Joseph G. and Margaret M. Dever Writers' Scholarship Fund was founded by Robert Muse, Esq. '42, in honor of his classmate, Joseph Dever, and Mr. Dever's wife Margaret, who taught English at Boston College. The Dever Fellowship is intended to assist a member of the graduating class who proposes to make a career in writing, as Mr. Dever did. The amount of the one-year Fellowship will be approximately \$5,000.
2. The candidate may nominate himself or herself, or may be nominated by a member or members of the faculty.
3. The candidate must have published at least one of his or her works in a campus publication or an external one during the candidate's years at Boston College.
4. The candidate must indicate a serious intention to write for publication as a continuing activity.

- Copy/copies of published materials (see #3 above), and an additional (up to 20 double-spaced pages) writing sample in any genre that represents the candidate's best work, published or unpublished. This submission may be a portion of a larger piece; indicate this on the submission.
- A two-page essay indicating the candidate's intentions to follow a career in writing.
