Research: Professor Derber's central interests are political economy, the sociology of militarism, political culture, and social change. His research and teaching involve a critique of empire, globalization and corporate power and the prospects for a shift toward a more democratic order in the US and the world. His books include *Corporation Nation* (St. Martin's, 2001), *People Before Profit* (Picador, 2003), *Regime Change Begins at Home* (Berrett-Koehler, 2004), *Hidden Power* (Berrett-Koehler, 2005) and *The Wilding of America*, 4th. ed. (2006) Derber advocates public sociology and works closely with progressive activist groups both on and off campus.

Current Projects: Derber is currently finishing a book called *Morality Wars: How Empires, The Born Again, And The Politically Correct Do Evil In The Name Of Good.*
