**2005 - 2007** *Engaging Workers and Improving Care*: A collaborative study sponsored by Service Employees International Union (SEIU), with Brandeis University, examining the effects of a labor/management project on careworkers and care receivers.

**2004 – 2005** *Better Jobs and Better Care*: A collaborative study funded by Robert Wood Johnson Foundation and Atlantic Philanthropy with Brandeis University, studying job and care quality in long-term care facilities in Massachusetts, with a focus frontline careworkers.

**2002-2003** Designed and wrote *Lower-Income Work and Family Life* project, a follow-up on key themes from previous research on the effects of parents working long hours, coupled with earning low wages, on children, family and community life in low-income America.

**2001-2002** *Harvard University Law School: Research Fellow –Fellowship on Border Crossings*, a research and public policy project comparing American and global human rights projects and economic development practices.

**2000-2002** Designed and wrote *Across the Boundaries*, multi-city funded study for a two year period by the Casey and Ford Foundations, for Radcliffe Institute for Advanced Study, Harvard University.
