### Community Service Program

The Carroll School has made a commitment to instill a strong sense of community service in its MBA graduates. In an effort to align this commitment with the program, all MBA students must fulfill a requirement of 20 hours of service to others through meaningful work as volunteers.

#### Goals:

- 1) Promote the personal, social, and civic development of our students.
- 2) Provide students with experience working with community-based organizations and individuals.
- 3) Continue to foster real-time experiential learning through this opportunity to leverage individual skills and expertise in a service capacity.
- 4) Further the Boston College, Jesuit tradition of service.

#### Base Guidelines:

- 1) All students must complete 20 hours of community service during the time frame between enrollment in the program and graduation.
- 2) We encourage students to combine longstanding personal interests and personal skills with their service requirements.
- 3) Service may be done individually or with a group.
- 4) Service must meet the needs of more than your immediate family, your employer, or the University.
- 5) The student can receive no monetary compensation for the service.
- 6) The service offers the student the potential to give and grow.
- 7) Internships and political campaigns are not considered community service.
- 8) All service must be documented in writing and submitted to Kathleen Joyce for approval by the Community Service Committee.
