General Information

Commencement 2007 will be held on Friday, May 25, at 2:00 p.m. on the Newton Campus Field Hockey Field. As some 1,500 guests are expected to attend this event, it is recommended that graduates and their guests read and be guided by the information contained here. It has been prepared in an effort to anticipate as many preliminary questions as possible. A more detailed guide will follow in the spring.

If you drive, allow ample time for reaching the campus. Travel is extremely slow because of heavy traffic.

All graduates should be in assembly areas at the Quonset Hut by 1:00 p.m. The academic procession for the Commencement will begin at 2:00 p.m. Family and guests should be seated by that time. The Commencement will take approximately two hours.

Guests should remember that there will be a fair amount of walking between events; comfortable footwear is recommended. Since the Commencement and a number of other ceremonies are held outdoors, it is suggested that guests also bring suitable protection against the heat of the day. Water stations will be located throughout the grounds.

Invitations

Commencement invitations will be distributed on April 11th and 12th in the Student Lounge (East Wing 100). Additional invitations will be available in the Dean for Student's Office after April 13th. You are not limited to the number of guests you may invite to Commencement and related events.

Garb

You will be measured and given your Commencement garb on Wednesday, April 11, and Thursday, April 12, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., in the East Wing Student Lounge (EW100). Rental cost for the Commencement garb is \$35.25 (cash, check or credit card). If you are not able to pick up your cap and gown at this time, it will be available the day of Commencement at 1:00 pm in the Quonset Hut.

Disabled Access

Any graduate whose parents or other guests are disabled may obtain a special parking and seating permit. A copy of a handicap registration or a doctor's note will be required as verification of disability. Permits may be obtained from Joan Manna in the Dean's Office, 307 Stuart, two weeks prior to Commencement.

There will be special seating for the disabled to view the Commencement ceremonies. Other guests are requested not to occupy this reserved area.

Pictures and Videotapes

A professional photographer will take pictures of each graduate receiving his or her diploma. In early April you will receive information about placing orders from the photographer, Commencement Photos, Inc. of Tewksbury, MA. Directions

Boston College Law School is located in Newton, Massachusetts. The campus is approximately six miles west of the city of Boston. Below are directions from various locations.

From Points North and South:

Take Interstate 95 (Route 128) to Exit 24 (Route 30). Proceed east on Route 30, also known as Commonwealth Avenue, and follow for about six miles to Centre Street, take a left. Boston College Law School is located approximately one mile on the left.

From Points West:

Take the Massachusetts Turnpike (Route 90) to Exit 17. At the first set of lights after the exit ramp, take a right onto Centre Street. Follow Centre Street through two set of lights, and Boston College Law School is located on right.

From Downtown Boston:

Take the Massachusetts Turnpike (Route 90) to Exit 17. Take a left over the bridge after passing the Sheraton Newton. Take the first right onto Centre Street. Follow above directions from Centre Street.

From Logan Airport:

Follow signs to Route 90 (Massachusetts Turnpike) Take Route 90 West to Exit 17. Then follow same directions as from Downtown Boston.

Rain Plan

In case of inclement weather, the Commencement ceremony and the reception following will be held in Conte Forum on the Main Campus. The Baccalaureate Mass and the luncheon following the Mass will be held on the Newton Campus, regardless of the weather. Announcements concerning changes will be posted on one of the following telephone numbers by 8:30 on the morning of graduation.
