## SIX WAYS TO RECRUIT BC LAW STUDENTS

### ON-CAMPUS FALL/SPRING RECRUITING

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Last year several hundred employers recruited on campus at Boston College Law School. On-campus recruiting is the most effective way to meet our students and includes private interview rooms for each interviewer and lunch. Each on-campus schedule will allow you to interview a total of 14 to 20 students per schedule/per day. Resumes of interested students will be forwarded to you approximately three weeks before your interview date for pre-screening and interview selection. **You may select 75% of your schedule and we will add the remaining 25% through a preference lottery system.**

Boston College Law School's on-campus schedule will begin on Tuesday, August 25, 2009. We welcome and look forward to your participation. To help make the most of your time in the Boston area, we will help coordinate your visit here with visits to any other local school. We can also arrange and host interviews for students from other schools if that will assist your planning. Please let us know of your needs when you register with us.
