The ERME Master of Education (M.Ed) program combines the study of research design, statistical methods, and testing and assessment with a research focus on major contemporary education policy issues.

The Fifth Year Program is an accelerated master's program (for Boston College students) which combines the Bachelor of Arts or Sciences with the Master of Education in the Lynch School.
