### The 5<sup>th</sup> Year Program *in* Educational Research, Measurement, and Evaluation (ERME)



The **ERME Master of Education (M.Ed)** program combines the study of research design, statistical methods, and testing and assessment with a research focus on major contemporary education policy issues.

The **5<sup>th</sup> Year Program** is an accelerated master's program (for Boston College students) which combines the Bachelor of Arts or Sciences with the Master of Education in the Lynch School.

### **WHAT TO KNOW...**

- Students in any undergraduate school at BC can apply.
- Get your Bachelor's degree and Master's degree in 5 years.

### **WHAT TO DO...**

- Students interested in a 5<sup>th</sup> Year Program should consult with the Lynch School Office of Graduate Student Services, Campion 135, during the spring semester of junior year.
- Without proper advisement, and early acceptance into a Master's degree program, students will be unable to complete the program in five years.
