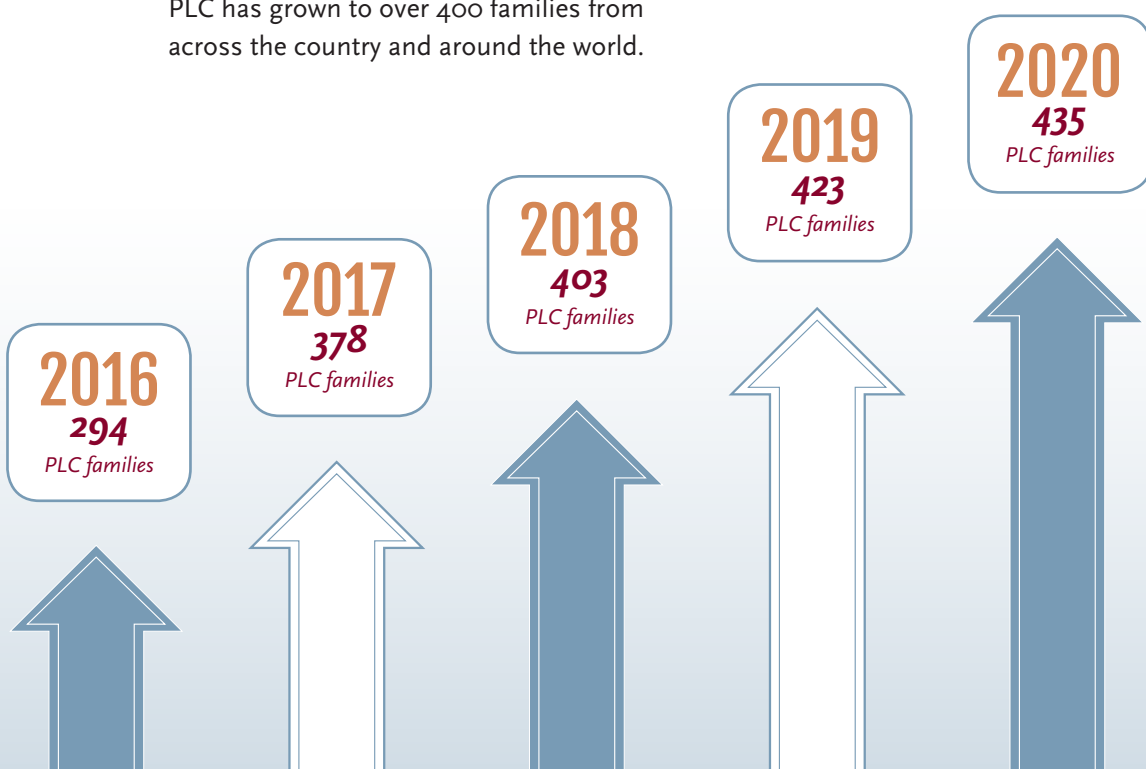
# Engaged
