



Academic Year COVID-19 Recommendations for Off-Campus Students, 2021-2022

This document outlines recommendations for students living off campus at Boston College during the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. Please read through it carefully.

As the progress of the COVID-19 pandemic remains uncertain, Boston College may recommend students living off campus take additional measures beyond what is currently in place to help protect the health and safety of the Boston College community. Boston College will operate within regulations set forth by municipal, state, and federal government agencies, and will expect the same of off-campus students.

Amended recommendations may include, but are not limited to, the following:

Adjustments to guest limits;

- Reserving the right to relocate any infected student, or any student deemed a close contact, for self-quarantine or isolation, as determined by University Health Services;
- Modifying off-campus programming to adhere to applicable public health guidelines;
- Requiring physical distancing and other personal hygiene practices, including the use of facemasks; and
- Modifying conduct policies applicable to students.

If Boston College institutes any of the above or other recommendations, students will be informed in as timely a fashion as possible.
