Graduate Staff Position Application Process

For All GRM and GM Grad Positions:

The Office of Residential Life, in conjunction with the School of Theology and Ministry (STM), will begin collecting applications throughout the Spring Semester. Once admitted to the STM students may work with their adviser and/or the Service Center to submit a resume and materials for review. Please note that the Office of Residential Life is committed to supporting students who are pursuing careers in the profession of higher education. With that in mind, strong preference will be given to applicants who have been accepted into the Boston College Higher Education Administration or International Higher Education programs.

In general, the application/selection process for all graduate assistantships in the Division of Student Affairs (which includes Residential Life) begins after students have been admitted to the Higher Education program in mid February. Once you have been accepted into this program, please coordinate with the administrative staff for the program who will forward your résumé to our selection committee for review. Interviews begin on Admitted Students Day in February.
