COVID-19 Addendum to the 2021-2022 Conditions for Residency

This Addendum modifies the Conditions for Residency (Housing Contract). Please read this carefully.

As the progress of the COVID-19 pandemic remains uncertain, Boston College housing and housing policies for the 2021-2022 academic year may be adjusted in the future in order to help protect health and safety of the Boston College community, as well as to abide by regulations set forth by municipal, state, and federal government agencies. Policy amendments may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Adjustments to guest policies;
- Modifications in building or room occupancy, which may require changes to housing assignments;
- Reserving the right to relocate any infected student, or any student deemed a close contact, for self-quarantine or isolation, as determined by University Health Services;
- Modifying residential programming to adhere to applicable public health guidelines;
- Requiring resident physical distancing and other personal hygiene practices, including the use of facemasks; and
- Modifying conduct policies applicable to residents.

If Boston College implements any of the above or other changes related to housing, students will be informed in as timely a fashion as possible. For reference, the [2020-2021 COVID-19 Housing Addendum](#) illustrates the nature of the amendments in place during the 2020-2021 year. While the University expects that fewer adjustments will need to be made during the 2021-2022 year, we cannot definitively establish next year's policies at this time.

By signing this agreement, you acknowledge that residency at Boston College and the Conditions for Residency may be adjusted at any time to comply with health regulations and guidelines, and to help protect the health and safety of the Boston College community.
