Good Afternoon,

We hope this email finds you well as you enjoy the remaining weeks of summer and prepare to arrive at Boston College for the Fall 2022 semester! We are looking forward to your arrival! Below you will find information pertaining to move-in dates, move-in appointments, and the Early Arrival application process.

Move-In Dates & Times:

As a reminder, below are the move-in dates for incoming First-Year, Transfer, and International Exchange students. These dates can also be found on the Office of Residential Life Fall Opening website.

- 1. Orientation Session 7 Move-In: Sunday, August 21st, 9:00am-2:30pm
 - a. For students attending Orientation 7, more information pertaining to your move-in process will be sent prior to your move-in date. You do not need to sign up for a move-in appointment or submit an Early Arrival application.
- 2. International Exchange Student Move-In: Monday, August 22nd, 8:00am-8:00pm
 - a. For students attending International Student Orientation, more information pertaining to your move-in process will be sent prior to your move-in date. <u>You do not need to sign up for a move-in appointment or submit an Early Arrival application.</u>
- 3. First-Year Student Move-In: Thursday, August 25th, 8:00am-4:00pm (students will need to sign up for a move-in appointment)
- 4. Transfer Student Move-In: Friday, August 26th & Saturday August 27th, 8:00am-5:00pm (students will need to sign up for a move-in appointment)
- 5. Late Arrivals Move-In: Sunday, August 28th, 10:00am-5:00pm (students will need to sign up for a move-in appointment)

Move-In Appointment Sign Ups

Fall Move-In Appointment sign-ups are now live and can be accessed via the Agora Portal → My ResLife →Fall Move-In Appointments. Below are some items to note regarding the Move-In Appointment Sign Up process:

- ALL students will need to sign-up for a Move-in Appointment by Monday, August 15th. You will
 not be able to move into your room without first being checked in. Specific details on the checkin locations will be forthcoming.
- There are limited appointments for each day and residence hall, and they are on a first-come, first-served basis. We cannot stress enough the importance of adhering to scheduled times.
- Students may only select one move-in appointment. Only students with an approved Early Arrival application will be able to sign up for an Early Arrival move-in appointment. If you are awaiting a

decision on your Early Arrival application, we recommend you still sign up for a Fall Move-In appointment in the event your Early Arrival request does not get approved.

Early Arrival Application Process

Early Arrivals are limited and will require advanced approval. Early Arrival applications will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis and approved based on reasoning and requested date of arrival. The application is open until **Monday, August 15th** via the Agora Portal → My ResLife → Forms. Please note that most individual **Early Arrival requests will not be approved, so we ask that you plan accordingly in the event your request is not approved.**

<u>Group Early Arrivals:</u> Only a limited number of approved groups will be permitted to move in early. Residential Life will be contacting group coordinators who have received an approved group early arrival request and will coordinate for students part of those groups. If you have any questions regarding your group's early arrival request, please contact your group coordinator for updates and next steps.

<u>Individual Early Arrivals:</u> Students with extenuating circumstances may apply for an early arrival beginning Tuesday, August 23rd with detailed reasoning.

All INDIVIDUAL students arriving early are highly encouraged to participate in Welcome Wagon to help move-in the Class of 2025 on Thursday, August 25th. Students that participate in Welcome Wagon will be assigned 1-2 shifts from 8am-5pm. More details will be provided for approved early arrivals participating in Welcome Wagon.

There will be an early arrival fee of \$75/night prior to the residence halls opening. Students who arrive as part of an approved early arrival group will receive an early arrival fee waiver for up to two nights; individual students participating in Welcome Wagon will receive an early arrival fee waiver for up to two nights.

Further details regarding move-in flow, reminders, and your specific check-in location will be communicated to students prior to move-in. In the meantime, if you have any questions or concerns, email transitions@bc.edu or visit the Office of Residential Life website for additional updates.
