

My Account login now quicker and simpler



The My Account login process has recently undergone a significant change. This change has been implemented in order to improve the security and reliability of the login process. The new process is designed to provide users with a secure and convenient way to access their account information. With My Account you'll have information about your coverage, immediate access to view and print your ID cards and access to your claim history, including your explanation of benefits (EOBs).

Signing up is easy!

- 1. Go to myaccount.uhcsr.com.
- 2. If you have an existing HealthSafe ID, click Sign In. If not, click on Register Now.
- Follow the on-screen prompts to register. You will need your 7-digit SRID or Student ID/Civil ID/National ID (SACM).
 (Use your BC Eagle ID.)
- 4. Enter username and password of your choice.
- Choose a confirmation method. Once you confirm your email, you will need to sign in using the username and password you created.
 (For the email confirmation, use your BC email in username@bc.edu format, not the
