

## Rescinding your spring insurance waiver

Rescinding your waiver cancels your insurance waiver, resulting in you being enrolled in and charged for the BC student plan. The spring plan period is January 12 – August 6, 2024.

1. Log in to your BC My Services account ([www.bc.edu/myservices](http://www.bc.edu/myservices)).  
In the Account and Personal Info section, select Medical Insurance Waiver.
2. Select the green “Provide or Update Medical Insurance Information” button.
