STUDENT HOURS AT BOSTON COLLEGE

(Applies to Graduate, Undergraduate, and Non-BC Students)

Payroll Form Statement

I understand that as an Undergraduate Student at Boston College, or as an Undergraduate Non-BC Student working at Boston College, I may not work more than 20 hours per week during the academic year, and that this is an aggregate limit that applies to all compensated work at Boston College, whether I have one position or more than one position. I also understand that I may work more than 20 hours (but less than 30) per week between semesters and during Spring break. During the summer I may work more than 30 hours per week (but no more than 40 hours), but any period during which I average 30 or more hours per week may not exceed 12 weeks.

I understand that as a Graduate or Professional Student at Boston College, or as a Graduate or Professional Non-BC Student working at Boston College, I may not work more than 29 hours per week during the academic year, and that this is an aggregate limit that applies to all compensated work at Boston College, whether I have one position or more than one position. I also understand that I may work no more than 29 hours per week between semesters and during Spring break. During the summer I may work more than 30 hours per week (but no more than 40 hours), but any period during which I average 30 or more hours per week may not exceed 12 weeks.

I understand that as an International Student on an F-1 or J-1 visa, I may not work more than 20 hours per week while school is in session, as cited in immigration regulations, and that this is the aggregate limit that applies to all compensated work at Boston College. I also understand that I may work full-time up to 40 hours per week for a maximum of 12 weeks on campus during vacation periods over the summer (if not taking classes) and that I may work up to 29 hours per week between semesters and Spring break. I also understand that not complying with these immigration guidelines may be a violation of F-1 or J-1 visa status.
