Summer Stipends 2024

The Winston Center for Leadership and Ethics engages students, faculty, staff, and alumni in the intellectual exploration of leadership and ethics in business and society.

Description:

The Winston Center welcomes applications from students who engage in uncompensated part-time or full-time internships that allow them to cultivate their leadership skills in local, state, or federal government, public interest groups, non-governmental organizations, advocacy work, direct service, research, and education during the summer.

Eligibility:

All BC undergraduate students are welcome to submit an application. Please note, you need to be enrolled at BC in Fall 2024 to be eligible.

Application Procedures:

Students must submit:

- A description of the organization for which you will work, along with a brief summary of the work you will perform, including number of weeks and hours per week of the internship term (no more than 2 doublespaced pages)
- A personal statement describing the reasons for your interest in the position and how it aligns with the Winston Center's mission (no more than 1 double-spaced page)
- An academic letter of recommendation from a faculty member
- A copy of your official transcript
- A copy of your resume
- The official offer letter from the organization which must indicate whether the internship will be in person or remote, and confirmation of the weeks and hours you will work

Deadline:

Application materials should be submitted via email to <u>winston.center@bc.edu</u> by May 6, 2024. Decisions will be sent by May 13.
