# **RESEARCH AND SCHOLARSHIP:**

#### **Narrative**

My research and scholarship are focused on exploring the experience of patients with chronic illness across the care trajectory from hospitalization through discharge to the community. I have used both quantitative and qualitative methodologies to explore this phenomenon in patients postoperatively (Project Manager, PI, Co-PI), with internal cardiac defibrillators (co investigator), COPD (PI), long-term oral treatment for breast cancer (PI) and HIV symptoms related to treatment (Co-PI). Findings from these studies suggest that patients who are older, have multiple chronic conditions and are caregivers of others are challenged to follow the treatment plan because specialty care is not coordinated across providers, tailored according to age, planned in consideration of the whole person and ignores how roles and relationships factor into care. My goal is to develop and test person centered self care interventions aimed at improving the experience of older adult caregivers who have chronic illness. Additionally, I have been fortunate to mentor and collaborate with nurses at MGH, students, faculty and interdisciplinary colleagues in their pursuit of research and scholarship. Many of these relationships have continued to develop over a number of years and continue to develop over the ensuing years.

#### **TEACHING AND ADVISING ACTIVITIES: BRIEF STATEMENT OF TEACHING**

EFFECTIVENESS: In my teaching and advising, I work together with the students with the goal of infusing the Jesuit ideal of cura personalis, care of the whole person. I encourage them to be reflective, lifelong learners in service to others. I mentor them to be leaders and to challenge themselves and learn from their mistakes. In terms of my own effectiveness as a teacher, I have consistently ranked at or above the CSON benchmark on student evaluations. In an effort to assure my own continuous improvement, I attend teaching workshops, learn and implement new strategies in the classroom to enhance the experience. I have been invited to speak as a guest lecturer at Boston College CSON, MGH IHP, Northeastern University, Endicott College, Catholic University in Portugal on several topics including various chronic conditions, advanced care planning, difficult conversations. theory based care, qualitative research, scholarly publication, and my program of research. I have been an advisor to 10-15 Master's students per year and served as a Keys to Inclusive Leadership (KILN) mentor to both undergraduate and graduate students. I have served as the Adult Gerontology Program Director from 2005 - 2020. In 2020, the Adult Gerontology Program was ranked 12<sup>th</sup> by the U.S. News and World Report. In my role as Program Director, I have helped many graduates of the AG NP program discern opportunities and achieve successful positions as NPs post-graduation. Grateful for that support, many former students now serve as preceptors for our students; several have returned to BC for to further their education. As a mentor, I have worked with undergraduate, masters and PhD students to present their work locally, nationally and internationally as well as in the publication of peer reviewed papers. More recently, as I have become more involved in the PhD program teaching several courses in that program. I have served as both a Fellowship advisor and academic advisor. I have mentored my PhD students to seek funding. Thus far, with my mentorship, they have collectively have secured \$105,500 in competitive external research support.
