UPPER LEVEL EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING BOSTON COLLEGE LAW SCHOOL

A course will satisfy the "Experiential Learning" requirement at Boston College if the primary goal of the course is to engage students in real client or simulated lawyering exercises, and may include skills such as interviewing, counseling, negotiation, fact development and analysis, trial practice, document drafting, conflict resolution, organization and management of legal work, collaboration, cultural competency, and self-evaluation.

Boston College Law School clinics and externships provide opportunities for students to earn academic credit by working in legal practice settings. Through this work students gain hands-on experience and build professional skills by engaging in substantial legal work under the supervision of experienced attorneys. Academic credits associated with clinics and externships, including credits for contemporaneous seminars which focus on self-reflection, ethics, professional development, and other issues that arise, satisfy the "Experiential Learning" requirement.

NOTE: One course can count towards satisfying the Perspectives requirement and *either* the upper-level writing or experiential learning. One course cannot count towards both upper-level writing and experiential learning.
