Educational Theater Minor For Lynch student only

This minor provides drama education and theatre training to those who hope to include theatre as a subject they teach and practice in school settings and/or to those who want to use creative dramatics and applied theatre techniques as teaching tools in other institutional settings. Lynch School students are eligible to declare this 20 credit minor. The minor consists of six courses (**18 credits**) and two, one credit labs (one prep and one run crew lab).
