This minor provides drama education and theatre training to those who hope to include theatre as a subject they teach and practice in school settings and/or to those who want to use creative dramatics and applied theatre techniques as teaching tools in other institutional settings. This 20 credit minor consists of six courses (**18 credits**) and two, one credit labs.
