On Thursday, October 13th, at approximately 10:15 p.m., the Boston and Boston College Police Departments responded to an off-campus attempted residential burglary in the area of Kirkwood Road, Brighton. The victim reported that an unidentified male, thin build, approximately 6 foot tall, wearing a white REI zip-up rain hoodie, light-colored cloth mask and black gloves had attempted to gain access into the residence on two difference occasions this date. The unidentified male was observed leaving the area in what appeared to be a dark-colored Jeep Wrangler or similar style vehicle.





As a reminder the Boston College Police Department encourages you to do the following:

- Lock your doors and windows. This includes patio doors and windows on upper floors, and keep those access points secured at all times.
- Keep items such as ladders secured and away from your residence.
- Be aware of your surroundings and get to know your neighbors.
- Avoid leaving valuables in plain site from windows.
- Report suspicious activity and persons to police <u>immediately</u>, with as much detailed information as possible.
