On Saturday, January 28th, at approximately 7:20 p.m., the Boston and Boston College Police Departments responded to an off-campus residence for a report of a suspicious person, and possible attempted breaking & entering in the area of Foster Street, Brighton. The victim reported that an unidentified male wearing a hooded sweatshirt was observed looking around through their home camera at the rear door. Upon further investigation, there were no signs of an attempt to force entry, nor was anything reported missing.

As a reminder the Boston College Police Department encourages you to do the following:
□ Lock your doors and windows at all times. This includes patio doors, and windows on upper floors.
☐ Keep items such as ladders secured and away from your residence.
☐ Be aware of your surro <mark>undings and get to know your neighbo</mark> rs.
☐ Avoid leaving valuables in plain site from windows.
□ Report suspicious activity and persons to police immediately , with as much detailed information as possible.
