I am writing with an update regarding our shared efforts to identify the College's next Dean of the Boston College Law School and a worthy successor to Vince Rougeau.

We would like to thank all of you who participated in recent conversations with our consultants Julie Tea and Julie Williams-Krishnan of Storbeck Search and those of you who completed the Stakeholder Survey. Your thoughtful comments provided the basis for the creation of the search prospectus, a valuable tool that will be used to solicit nominations and recruit candidates nationally. We invite you to review the finalized copy which is available on Boston College's website and at the Storbeck Search site.

As you review the search prospectus, please pay particular attention to the attributes most highly desired in our new Dean. We urge you to suggest people you know who could serve effectively in this critically important position, or those you think might know of potential candidates. Our committee is well aware that the success of our search depends on the involvement of all members of the Boston College community. Please rest assured that names and information will be treated with full confidentiality.

Over the next several weeks, we will generate a national candidate pool through nominations received from you and others, inquiries at other colleges and universities similar to Boston College in scope and mission, advertising in *The Chronicle of Higher Education* and Inside Higher Ed and on a number of other relevant websites, and the work of our search firm. In December the search committee will begin to narrow the candidate pool.
