

A VIRTUAL PILGRIMAGE WITH A COMMUNITY OF PRAYER







THE JOURNEY WITH IGNATIUS APP IS A 12-WEEK VIRTUAL PILRIMAGE.

This FREE virtual pilgrimage app is based on the life of Saint Ignatius Loyola, the founder of the Society of Jesus, the Jesuit Order, in 1540.

The app features a unique weekly location and an accompanying theme, both of which are introduced through videography and key excerpts from the biography and autobiography of St. Ignatius.

The app aims to facilitate users' growth in mind, body, and soul by featuring daily readings from Jesuit Sources, a Sacred Scripture verse for daily prayer, selected reflections, and the tracking of participants' steps. There is also weekly content for further prayer and reflection based on each week's theme, including a community forum to share reflections and engage with and pray for other pilgrims from around the world.







LEARN ABOUT IGNATIUS

Each of the 12 sites has a video introduction from research scholars on the location and its importance in Ignatius' life. In addition, each site is centered around a certain theme, in which a reflection will be provided for the pilgrim.

Choose from daily prayer content and activities from Scripture, Jesuit Sources, guided Ignatian Examens, and reflections from our partner Institutions.






COMMUNITY OF PRAYER

JOURNEY

This tab marks the progression of your pilgrimage and contains content and information regarding the theme and location of the week,

including a video presentation, excerpts from the biography and autobiography of St. Ignatius, and the featured high school for the week, whose students have provided the daily witness reflections in the "Today" tab.



TODAY

This tab marks your daily activity. In undertaking this virtual pilgrimage, it is intended that the pilgrim grow in mind, body, and soul. This tab consists of daily prayers (soul), a step count of your journey (body), Jesuit Sources (mind), reflections (witness) and examinations of conscience (examen).







COMMUNITY


The community guest books are where pilgrims can interact and share reflections, quotes, pictures, prayers, etc., of a spiritual dimension. There is a guestbook with an optional reflection question in each of the 12 locations. This platform is meant for spiritual sharing and uplifting.
