On Thursday, July 30th, 2015 two female students reported that while walking off campus in the area of Lake Street in Brighton a small black in color “sporty” style sedan pulled along side of them and stopped. A white male described to be in his early 20’s wearing a baseball cap and white in color tank top opened the drivers door and exposed himself in front of them. The victims were able to obtain a partial plate number of “RK1”, prior to the vehicle pulling off and driving away on Lake Street.

On Tuesday, July 21st, 2015 a similar incident that took place in the area of “Brookline Avenue” was report to the Boston Police Department. The suspect in that incident matches the description on the male party in the most recent incident.
