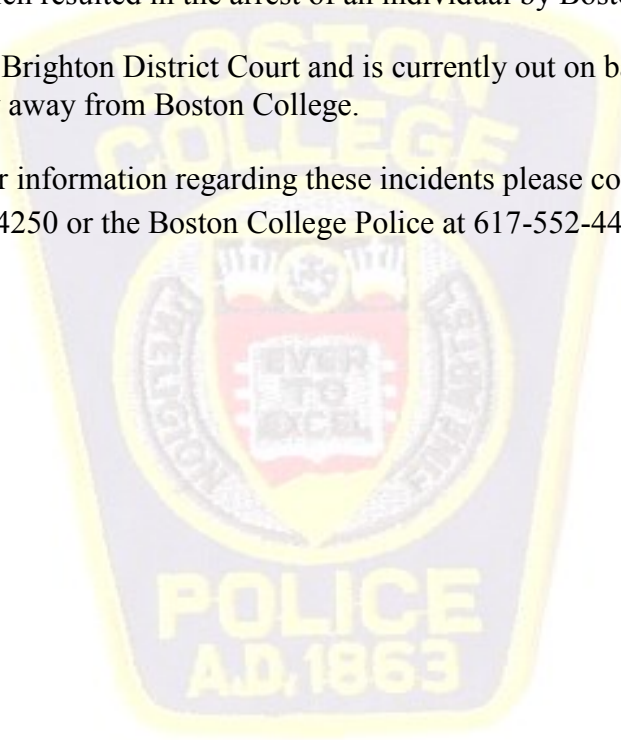

On Tuesday, September 1st, 2015 the BC Police Department responded to an “assist other agency” request on a report of a male subject exposing himself in the area of South Street, Brighton. Reports indicated a similar description to previously reported incidents. Boston College Police Officers were able to locate the suspect’s vehicle and quickly coordinate a response by the Boston and Newton Police Departments, which resulted in the arrest of an individual by Boston Police.

The suspect appeared at Brighton District Court and is currently out on bail, with a GPS tracking device and an order to stay away from Boston College.
