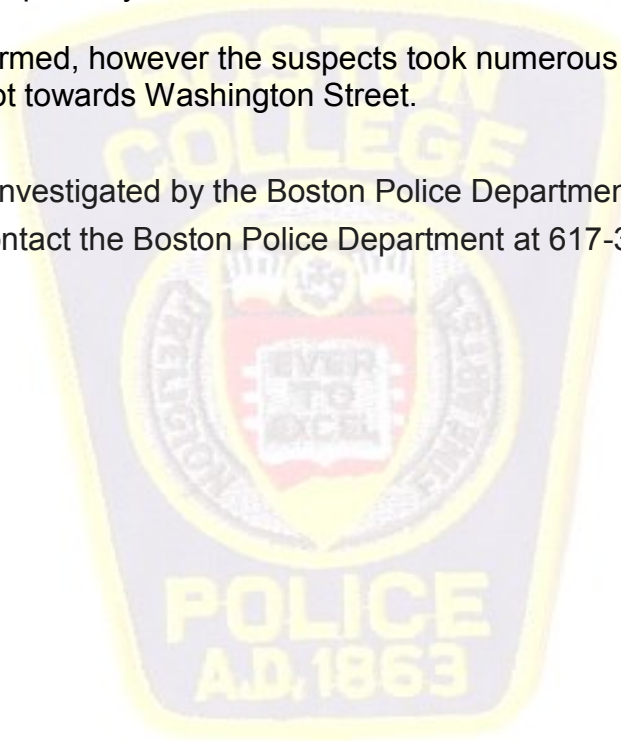

On Sunday December 6, 2015 at approximately 11:45 PM an individual with no affiliation to Boston College reported to the Boston Police Department that he was robbed at gun-point while walking on Lake Street, near Rogers Park. The victim described the suspects as a white male 25-35 years old, with a brown beard and wearing a grey hooded sweat-shirt, and the second as a black/non-Hispanic male 25-35 years old with no facial hair, wearing a red shirt and possibly a black hooded sweatshirt.

The victim was not harmed, however the suspects took numerous valuables before fleeing the area on foot towards Washington Street.
